

**REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

**MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:**

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3121: Appropriation; Military Dept.- Support.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
  
2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5           SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of  
8 defraying the general expenses of the operation of the  
9 Mississippi National Guard for the fiscal year beginning July 1,  
10 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$       5,182,220.00.

11           SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Mississippi National  
13 Guard, out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of

14 the Camp Shelby Timber Fund--No. 3700, as created by Chapter 187,  
 15 Laws of 1954, as amended; the Service Contract Fund--No. 3701;  
 16 the Camp Shelby Base Operations Fund--No. 3705; the Air National  
 17 Guard Training Site Base Operations Fund--No. 3709; and the  
 18 Education Enhancement Fund, for the purpose of carrying out the  
 19 provisions of applicable statutes and federal/state agreements  
 20 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending  
 21 June 30, 2002.....  
 22 ..... \$ 47,981,407.00.

23 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions  
 24 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

6 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the  
7 terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

8 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to  
9 replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for  
10 salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn  
11 and no longer available.

12 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the agency's  
13 budget request for Fiscal Year 2003 shall be submitted to the Joint  
14 Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to  
15 the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget  
16 request process.

17 SECTION 5. All funds authorized to be expended herein shall be  
18 expended and otherwise accounted for in accordance with the provisions of  
19 Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. If not needed for other  
20 purposes, the Adjutant General is hereby expressly authorized to invest any  
21 part of or all monies herein appropriated out of the Camp Shelby Timber  
22 Fund at the highest rate of interest obtainable and credit interest accruing  
23 on such investments to the respective fund. Such monies may be invested  
24 in any short-term bonds, notes or other direct obligations of the United  
25 States of America or the State of Mississippi or any county or municipality of  
26 this state, which said county or municipal bonds have been approved by a  
27 reputable bonds attorney or have been validated by a decree of the court,  
28 and in any event the said bonds, notes or obligations in which such funds  
29 are invested shall mature or be redeemable prior to the time the funds so  
30 invested will be needed for the refund or refunds herein provided for.

31 SECTION 6. The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds which  
32 may become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the  
33 Mississippi National Guard is hereby authorized and approved, provided  
34 such expenditures are reported and otherwise handled in accordance with  
35 the state budget law, same being Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi  
36 Code of 1972.

37 SECTION 7. The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds which  
38 may become available to the Mississippi National Guard for construction  
39 purposes is hereby authorized and approved, provided such receipts and  
40 expenditures are reported and otherwise handled in accordance with the  
41 state budget law, same being Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of  
42 1972.

43 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Two Million  
44 Sixty-four Thousand Five Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$2,064,516.00) shall be  
45 transferred from the State Department of Education for the support of the  
46 Youth Challenge Program at Camp Shelby.

47 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the  
48 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the  
49 proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the  
50 State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants  
51 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the  
52 manner provided by law.

53 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after  
54 July 1, 2001.
