**AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO**

**House Bill NO. 1548**

**By Representative(s) Simpson**

1       **AMEND** on line 83 before the semicolon by inserting the  
2 following: ", subject to the requirements of subsection (3) of  
3 this section"

4       **AMEND FURTHER** by inserting between line 84 and 85 the  
5 following:

6       (3) In the leasing or selling of naming rights to the civic  
7 center, the bureau is authorized to enter into contracts for the  
8 use of a commercial, corporate, business or private enterprise  
9 name on the building, literature, letterhead or other item, as  
10 contracted for, of the civic center, provided that the use of the  
11 civic center is limited to providing a place for conventions,  
12 entertainment, athletic events and other civic events. Such a  
13 contract shall be for a term that complies with law. In the  
14 discretion of the bureau, the term of the contract may extend  
15 beyond the terms of office of the members of the bureau. The  
16 contract shall provide compensation to the bureau that, in its  
17 determination, is fair and adequate consideration in exchange for  
18 the benefits, name recognition, advertising, potential returns and  
19 publicity to the private enterprise. Any such contract entered  
20 into before the effective date of this act is hereby ratified and

21 affirmed. The bureau may negotiate and enter into such a contract  
22 for naming rights, and all incidental rights associated therewith,  
23 in the same method as is authorized by law for procuring a  
24 contract for professional services. The provisions of this  
25 section do not authorize contracts for naming rights for any  
26 building other than the civic center, regardless of whether it is  
27 used for public meetings on occasion.
