11	(4) Reading the Journal
12	(5) Presentation of Petitions
13	(6) Reports of Standing Committees
14	(7) Reports of Select Committees
15	(8) Introduction of Bills and Concurrent Resolutions
16	(9) Reference of Bills and Concurrent Resolutions
17	(10) Presentation of Senate Resolutions
18	(11) Unfinished Business
19	(12) Consideration of Bills and Resolutions
20	(13) At Midnight on a deadline day, the Senate clock
21	shall determine the end of that calendar day regardless of whether
22	the Senate is then operating under the previous question. Any
23	measure pending before the Senate on a deadline upon which the
24	final vote has not been both taken and announced shall
25	automatically fail, and no announcement to the contrary may be
26	made by the Chair. If the Senate clock is not in working order,
27	the Presiding Officer shall keep the time.
