HOUSE BILL NO. 94

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-103-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO PRESCRIBE THE TUITION AT THE STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
3 LEARNING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-103-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:

7 37-103-25. (1) The * * * amount of fees to be paid by
8 undergraduate, resident students attending the * * *
9 state-supported institutions of higher learning * * * of the State
10 of Mississippi is fixed as follows:

20 The fees prescribed in this subsection are per each semester
21 (fall, spring) of the school year and include the tuition and
22 those fees that are required of all students at the respective
23 institutions.

24 (2) The boards of trustees of the community colleges and
25 junior colleges may prescribe the amount of fees to be paid by
26 resident students attending the state-supported community colleges
27 and junior colleges of the State of Mississippi.



28 (3) In prescribing the rates to be paid by residents of
29 other states, the total fees shall not be less than the average
30 cost per student from appropriated funds.

31 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
32 and after July 1, 2002.
