HOUSE BILL NO. 613

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 DELETE THE SALARIES OF THE CLERK OF THE SUPREME COURT AND STATE
3 LAW LIBRARIAN FROM THE OMNIBUS PAY SECTION; TO AMEND SECTIONS
4 9-3-14 AND 39-1-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE
5 SUPREME COURT TO FIX THE COMPENSATION OF THE CLERK AND STATE LAW
6 LIBRARIAN; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** Section 25-3-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9 amended as follows:

10 25-3-33. The annual salaries of the following appointive

136 **SECTION 2.** Section 9-3-14, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
137 amended as follows:

138 9-3-14. The Clerk of the Supreme Court shall be appointed by
139 majority vote of the Supreme Court and shall serve at the pleasure
140 of the court. The Supreme Court shall fix the compensation of the
141 Clerk of the Supreme Court, subject to the approval of the State
142 Personnel Board.

143 **SECTION 3.** Section 39-1-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
144 amended as follows:

145 39-1-1. (1) There shall be a State Library which shall
146 render law library services to the Supreme Court and other state
147 courts, to state officials and to the general public.

148 (2) The State Library shall be under the supervision and
149 control of the Mississippi Supreme Court, and the court shall be
150 empowered to promulgate policies and procedures necessary for the
151 efficient operation of the Library.

152 (3) The Supreme Court shall fix the compensation of the
153 State Law Librarian, subject to the approval of the State
154 Personnel Board.

155 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
156 and after July 1, 2002.
