HOUSE BILL NO. 727

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-46-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE DIVISION
- 3 OF MEDICAID TO PROVIDE NONEMERGENCY SERVICES FOR MEDICAID-ELIGIBLE
- 4 PERSONS SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS EMPLOYEES OF THE DIVISION OF
- 5 MEDICAID FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE TORT CLAIMS ACT; AND FOR RELATED
- 6 PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 11-46-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 11-46-1. As used in this chapter the following terms shall
- 11 have the meanings * * * ascribed in this section unless the
- 12 context otherwise requires:
- 13 (a) "Claim" means any demand to recover damages from a
- 14 governmental entity as compensation for injuries.
- 15 (b) "Claimant" means any person seeking compensation
- 16 under the provisions of this chapter, whether by administrative
- 17 remedy or through the courts.
- 18 (c) "Board" means the Mississippi Tort Claims Board.
- 19 (d) "Department" means the Department of Finance and
- 20 Administration.
- 21 (e) "Director" means the executive director of the
- 22 department who is also the executive director of the board.
- 23 (f) "Employee" means any officer, employee or servant
- 24 of the State of Mississippi or a political subdivision of the
- 25 state, including elected or appointed officials and persons acting
- on behalf of the state or a political subdivision in any official
- 27 capacity, temporarily or permanently, in the service of the state
- 28 or a political subdivision whether with or without compensation.
- The term "employee" shall not mean a person or other legal

- 30 entity while acting in the capacity of an independent contractor
- 31 under contract to the state or a political subdivision. * * *
- 32 However, * * * for purposes of the limits of liability provided
- 33 for in Section 11-46-15, the term "employee" shall include
- 34 physicians under contract to provide health services with the
- 35 State Board of Health, the State Board of Mental Health or any
- 36 county or municipal jail facility while rendering services under
- 37 the contract. In addition, the term "employee" includes
- 38 individuals who are under contract with the Division of Medicaid
- 39 under Section 43-13-117(36) to provide nonemergency services for
- 40 Medicaid-eligible persons, and those individuals shall be
- 41 considered as employees of the Division of Medicaid for the
- 42 purposes of the Tort Claims Act. The term "employee" shall also
- 43 include Mississippi Department of Human Services licensed foster
- 44 parents for the limited purposes of coverage under the Tort Claims
- 45 Act as provided in Section 11-46-8.
- 46 (g) "Governmental entity" means and includes the state
- 47 and political subdivisions as herein defined.
- (h) "Injury" means death, injury to a person, damage to
- 49 or loss of property or any other injury that a person may suffer
- 50 that is actionable at law or in equity.
- 51 (i) "Political subdivision" means any body politic or
- 52 body corporate other than the state responsible for governmental
- 53 activities only in geographic areas smaller than that of the
- 54 state, including but not limited to any county, municipality,
- 55 school district, community hospital as defined in Section
- 56 41-13-10, airport authority or other instrumentality thereof,
- 57 whether or not the body or instrumentality thereof has the
- 58 authority to levy taxes or to sue or be sued in its own name.
- (j) "State" means the State of Mississippi and any
- 60 office, department, agency, division, bureau, commission, board,
- 61 institution, hospital, college, university, airport authority or
- other instrumentality thereof, whether or not $\underline{\text{the}}$ body or

- 63 instrumentality thereof has the authority to levy taxes or to sue
- 64 or be sued in its own name.
- (k) "Law" means all species of law including but not
- 66 limited to any and all constitutions, statutes, case law, common
- 67 law, customary law, court order, court rule, court decision, court
- 68 opinion, court judgment or mandate, administrative rule or
- 69 regulation, executive order, or principle or rule of equity.
- 70 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 71 and after July 1, 2002.
