HOUSE BILL NO. 985

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-155, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE LICENSE TAG COMMISSION TO PURCHASE VEHICLE LICENSE TAGS FROM THE MISSISSIPPI PRISON INDUSTRIES CORPORATION; TO REPEAL 3 4 SECTION 27-19-157, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH PROVIDES THAT IF LICENSE TAGS ARE REQUIRED TO BE MADE BY PRISONERS AT THE STATE 5
- PENITENTIARY, THEN THE TAGS WILL BE PURCHASED FROM THE 6
- PENITENTIARY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 27-19-155, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9
- 10 amended as follows:
- 27-19-155. The license or numbered tag herein provided for 11
- shall be purchased by the License Tag Commission, composed of the 12
- Governor, Commissioner of Revenue, Attorney General, and the State 13
- Treasurer * * *. The License Tag Commission shall award the 14
- 15 contract for the manufacture and purchase of license tags to the
- Mississippi Prison Industries Corporation created under the 16
- Mississippi Prison Industries Act of 1990. The Mississippi Prison 17
- Industries Corporation shall begin manufacture of the license tags 18
- on July 1, 2002. The License Tag Commission is hereby authorized 19
- 20 and empowered to renegotiate any contract entered into for the
- purchase of license tags in order to obtain any other or 21
- additional tags necessitated by the passage of this article. 22
- 23 All license tags and numbered plates purchased under the
- provisions of this article, shall be paid for pursuant to an 24
- appropriation to be made for such purposes. All monies received 25
- by the State Tax Commission as registration or tag fees, either 26
- from the tax collectors, or from licenses issued by the State Tax 27
- 28 Commission, shall be paid into the State Treasury on the same day
- in which such funds are collected by the State Tax Commission. 29

- 30 **SECTION 2.** Section 27-19-157, Mississippi Code of 1972,
- 31 which provides that if license tags are required to be made by
- 32 prisoners at the State Penitentiary, then the tags will be
- 33 purchased from the Penitentiary, is repealed.
- 34 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 35 and after July 1, 2002.
