HOUSE BILL NO. 1068

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 DELETE THE REQUIREMENT THAT BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS ADOPT A
3 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOARD MEMBERS TO RECEIVE A SALARY
4 INCREASE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 25-3-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7 amended as follows:

8 25-3-13. The salaries of the members of the boards of
9 supervisors of the various counties are * * * fixed as full
10 compensation for their services.

11 The annual salary of each member of the board of supervisors
12 shall be based upon the total assessed valuation of his respective
13 county for the preceding taxable year in the following categories
14 and for the following amounts:

15 (a) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
16 less than Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), a salary of
17 Twenty-three Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars
18 (\$23,529.00);

19 (b) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
20 at least Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), but less than
21 Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00), a salary of
22 Twenty-four Thousand One Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars
23 (\$24,137.00);

24 (c) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
25 at least Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00), but less
26 than Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00), a salary of
27 Twenty-four Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-four Dollars
28 (\$24,744.00);



29 (d) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
30 at least Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00), but less
31 than Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), a salary of
32 Twenty-six Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-nine Dollars (\$26,869.00);

33 (e) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
34 at least Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), but less than
35 Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), a salary of
36 Twenty-eight Thousand Eighty-three Dollars (\$28,083.00);

37 (f) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
38 at least Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), but less
39 than One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), a
40 salary of Twenty-eight Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-four Dollars
41 (\$28,994.00);

42 (g) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
43 One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), but
44 less than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00), a
45 salary of Thirty-three Thousand Five Hundred Forty-eight Dollars
46 (\$33,548.00);

47 (h) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
48 Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00) or more, a salary
49 of Thirty-seven Thousand Three Hundred Forty-three Dollars
50 (\$37,343.00).

52 **SECTION 2.** The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
53 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
54 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
55 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
56 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
57 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
58 extended.

59 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
60 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
61 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
