HOUSE BILL NO. 1126

ENVIRONMENTAL MITIGATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. (1) When any state, public or private land or property is entitled to environmental protection under state or federal law, and the land or property is obtained or taken and used for a purpose which requires other land or property to be acquired and substituted for the land or property entitled to protection in order to mitigate damage to such land or property and/or the environment, the substituted land or property shall be located in the county in which the land or property entitled to protection is found, to the greatest extent practicable. Such substituted land or property shall be referred to as "the land or property acquired for environmental mitigation."

property acquired for environmental mitigation shall coordinate with the owner of the land or property entitled to environmental protection, with the appropriate state agency or governmental subdivision, or the United States Army Corps of Engineers, as the case may be. In any case in which there is a disagreement among the parties regarding the location of the land or property acquired for environmental mitigation, the agency or other governmental subdivision, or the United States Army Corps of
