HOUSE BILL NO. 1669

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
2 INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS  
3 AND TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT THAT BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS MUST  
4 ADOPT A RESOLUTION IN ORDER FOR THEIR SALARY INCREASES TO TAKE  
5 EFFECT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** Section 25-3-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
8 amended as follows:

9 25-3-13. The salaries of the members of the boards of  
10 supervisors of the various counties are \* \* \* fixed as full  
11 compensation for their services.

12 The annual salary of each member of the board of supervisors  
13 shall be based upon the total assessed valuation of his respective  
14 county for the preceding taxable year in the following categories  
15 and for the following amounts:

16 (a) For counties having a total assessed valuation of  
17 less than Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), a salary of  
18 Twenty-five Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-two Dollars  
19 (\$25,882.00);

20 (b) For counties having a total assessed valuation of  
21 at least Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), but less than  
22 Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00), a salary of  
23 Twenty-six Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-one Dollars (\$26,551.00);

24 (c) For counties having a total assessed valuation of  
25 at least Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00), but less  
26 than Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00), a salary of  
27 Twenty-seven Thousand Two Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$27,219.00);



28 (d) For counties having a total assessed valuation of  
29 at least Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00), but less  
30 than Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), a salary of  
31 Twenty-nine Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-six Dollars (\$29,556.00);

32 (e) For counties having a total assessed valuation of  
33 at least Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), but less than  
34 Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), a salary of Thirty  
35 Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-two Dollars (\$30,892.00);

36 (f) For counties having a total assessed valuation of  
37 at least Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), but less  
38 than One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), a  
39 salary of Thirty-one Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-four Dollars  
40 (\$31,894.00);

41 (g) For counties having a total assessed valuation of  
42 One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), but  
43 less than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00), a  
44 salary of Thirty-six Thousand Nine Hundred Three Dollars  
45 (\$36,903.00);

46 (h) For counties having a total assessed valuation of  
47 Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00) or more, a salary  
48 of Forty-one Thousand Seventy-eight Dollars (\$41,078.00).

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50 **SECTION 2.** The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi  
51 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,  
52 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the  
53 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States  
54 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the  
55 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and  
56 extended.

57 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
58 and after October 1, 2002, if it is effectuated on or before that  
59 date under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended  
60 and extended. If it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting



61 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended, after October 1,  
62 2002, this act shall take effect and be in force from and after  
63 the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting Rights  
64 Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
