6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State
9	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of
LO	Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building,
L1	Grounds and Real Property Management, for the purpose of
L2	reauthorizing the expenditure of State General Funds, as
L3	authorized in Senate Bill No. 3199, Regular Session of 1995,

- 75 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 76 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 77 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 78 and after July 1, 2002.
