HOUSE BILL NO. 1746

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE TOWN OF  
2 SMITHVILLE, MISSISSIPPI, TO EXTEND THE POLICE JURISDICTION OF THE  
3 TOWN OF SMITHVILLE OUTSIDE OF THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE  
4 MUNICIPALITY TO INCLUDE THE CAMPUS, PARKING LOTS AND BALL FIELDS  
5 OF THE SMITHVILLE SCHOOL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** (1) The governing authorities of the Town of  
8 Smithville, Mississippi, in their discretion, may extend the  
9 police jurisdiction of the Town of Smithville to an area one  
10 thousand (1,000) feet west, one thousand (1,000) feet north and  
11 one thousand (1,000) feet east on each side of the real property  
12 of the Smithville school campus, parking lots and ball fields in  
13 Monroe County, being partly within and partly outside of the Town  
14 of Smithville, the Smithville school land lying and being north of  
15 the centerline of the Smithville-Tremont Road within and outside  
16 of the corporate boundaries of the Town of Smithville, and to the  
17 west of a north/south line running perpendicular to the  
18 intersection of the Smithville-Tremont Road and the  
19 Smithville-Fulton Road in the Town of Smithville.

20 (2) Any police jurisdiction that the Town of Smithville may  
21 be granted under this act shall be concurrent with the  
22 jurisdiction of Monroe County.

23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
24 and after its passage.
