- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING APRIL AS ORGAN DONATION
- 2 AND RECOVERY MONTH FOR THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI.
- 3 WHEREAS, more than 67,000 Americans are waiting for organs to
- 4 become available; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in 1998, there were only 10,073 donors in the entire
- 6 United States; and
- 7 WHEREAS, every 16 minutes a new name is added to the waiting
- 8 list for an organ, while 13 people die every day waiting for a
- 9 lifesaving transplant; and
- 10 WHEREAS, almost 25% of all individuals waiting on a liver
- 11 transplant are under the age of 10; and
- 12 WHEREAS, over 90% of Mississippians waiting for an organ
- 13 transplant are African Americans, yet they make up less than 10%
- 14 of the state's donors; and
- 15 WHEREAS, one organ donor can save the lives of up to seven
- 16 individuals in need of a transplant; and
- 17 WHEREAS, one tissue donor can enhance the lives of more than
- 18 50 individuals; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi passed the "Gift of Life"
- 20 Act in 1998 that requires all families be given the option to
- 21 donate organs and tissue at the time of death:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
- 23 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
- 24 THEREIN, That we do hereby recognize the month of April as Organ
- 25 Donation and Recovery Month for the State of Mississippi.
