HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 45

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE MURRAH HIGH
2 SCHOOL LADY MUSTANGS BASKETBALL TEAM FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING
3 2001-2002 SEASON AND FOR WINNING THE STATE 5A CHAMPIONSHIP.

4 WHEREAS, the Murrah High School Lady Mustangs Basketball Team
5 finished the 2001-2002 season with a remarkable record of 32 wins
6 and three losses; and

7 WHEREAS, ranked No. 3 in The Clarion-Ledger poll, the Lady
8 Mustangs finished their sixth straight season with a record of at
9 least 30 wins; and

10 WHEREAS, the Lady Mustangs won the Class 5A State
11 Championship, beating Murrah High School Lady Mustangs with a
12 49-46 come-from-behind victory at the Mississippi Coliseum before
13 an estimated 5,000 sports fans; and

14 WHEREAS, the Murrah High School Lady Mustangs have been
15 superbly coached and inspired by Head Coach Anna Jackson, who has
16 broadened the Mustangs' knowledge of the game and refined their
17 skills in execution; and

18 WHEREAS, Head Coach Jackson has brought additional honor to
19 Murrah High School by becoming the first woman to win five state
20 championships; and

21 WHEREAS, the Lady Mustangs have developed a winning attitude
22 and cooperative spirit, and their activities and attitude reflect
23 great honor on Murrah High School; and

24 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives of
25 the State of Mississippi to recognize and commend excellence,
26 especially when evidenced by the youth of our state, who are its
