- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 55-13-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows:
- 55-13-35. (1) It shall be unlawful to construct or erect a 9
- building, advertising structure or other structure, of more than 10
- three (3) stories or thirty-five (35) feet in height, whichever is 11
- lesser, within one thousand (1,000) feet of the outside boundary 12
- of the Natchez Trace Parkway. Such restrictions on buildings and 13
- 14 structures shall apply notwithstanding that such area is located
- inside or outside a municipality and notwithstanding any other 15
- 16 provisions of law to the contrary.
- (2) It is the legislative intent of this section, in part, 17
- that possession of a building permit on July 1, 1988, shall not 18
- allow any construction after July 1, 1988, based on that permit. 19
- This section shall not apply to any building in existence on July 20
- 21 1, 1988.
- 22 (3) The following buildings or structures are exempt from
- the application of this section if they were constructed or under 23
- construction prior to July 1, 2002: 24
- (a) Silos, buildings and structures designed for 25
- agricultural use; 26
- 27 (b) Churches; and



- 28 (c) Any building or structure * * * on property
- 29 that * * * is owned by a public school district and used for
- 30 educational purposes * * *.
- 31 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after July 1, 2002.
