- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 55-13-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 55-13-35. (1) It shall be unlawful to construct or erect a
- 10 building, advertising structure or other structure, of more than
- 11 three (3) stories or thirty-five (35) feet in height, whichever is
- 12 lesser, within one thousand (1,000) feet of the outside boundary
- 13 of the Natchez Trace Parkway. Such restrictions on buildings and
- 14 structures shall apply notwithstanding that such area is located
- 15 inside or outside a municipality and notwithstanding any other
- 16 provisions of law to the contrary.
- 17 (2) It is the legislative intent of this section, in part,
- 18 that possession of a building permit on July 1, 1988, shall not
- 19 allow any construction after July 1, 1988, based on that permit.
- 20 This section shall not apply to any building in existence on July
- 21 1, 1988.
- 22 (3) The following buildings or structures are exempt from
- 23 the application of this section if they were constructed or under
- 24 construction prior to July 1, 2002:
- 25 <u>(a)</u> Silos, buildings and structures designed for
- 26 agricultural use;
- 27 (b) Churches; and

- 28 (c) Any building or structure * * * on property
- 29 that * * * is owned by a public school district and used for
- 30 educational purposes * * *.
- 31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after July 1, 2002.
