SENATE BILL NO. 2357

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW THE FEEDING OF DEER ON PRIVATE LANDS AND ALLOW HUNTING OF
- 3 DEER OVER THE FEED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 49-7-33. (1) It is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild
- 8 bird or wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings
- 9 of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of
- 10 calls of any kind, except a person:
- 11 (a) May use electrically amplified sound devices for
- 12 hunting coyote and crow;
- 13 (b) May use liquid scents for any animal or bird; and
- 14 (c) May feed deer with corn, oats, wheat, other grain
- or any other feed on privately owned or leased lands and hunt deer
- 16 over the feed.
- 17 (2) The commission, in its discretion, may relax the
- 18 restrictions regarding the use of lures or sound devices if a
- 19 condition arises or exists, as decided by the State Board of
- 20 Health or county board of health, that may endanger persons or
- 21 livestock in a certain community, county or area.

- 23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2002.
