1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 42 IN FORREST COUNTY AS THE "EVELYN GANDY PARKWAY"; TO PROVIDE THAT EACH SEGMENT OF THE PROPOSED REGIONAL THOROUGHFARE ENCIRCLING THE CITY OF HATTIESBURG SHALL, AS COMPLETED, BE DESIGNATED AS THE "EVELYN GANDY PARKWAY"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
6	WHEREAS, long-range plans developed by the
7	Hattiesburg-Petal-Forrest-Lamar Planning Organization propose a
8	transportation system encircling the City of Hattiesburg that is
9	currently referred to as the Regional Thoroughfare; and
10	WHEREAS, a Map has been developed by the
11	Hattiesburg-Petal-Forrest-Lamar Planning Organization specifying
12	the locations of the roads which will be a part of this Regional
13	Thoroughfare, which map is on file with the Office of Public
14	Services of the City of Hattiesburg; and

- WHEREAS, the Hattiesburg-Petal-Forrest-Lamar Planning
