- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-5-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- 12 63-5-9. The provisions of this chapter governing size,
- 13 weight and load shall not apply to:
- 14 (a) Fire apparatus;
- 15 (b) Road machinery;
- 16 (c) Vehicles operated under the terms of a special
- 17 permit issued as provided in this chapter;
- 18 (d) Any machinery or equipment used for normal farm
- 19 purposes only, having a width in excess of the maximum
- 20 requirements prescribed by this chapter, where such movement is
- 21 performed during daylight hours, within a radius of fifty (50)
- 22 miles of the point of origin thereof, and no part of such
- 23 operation or movement is upon any highway designated and known as
- 24 a part of the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways,
- 25 or accesses thereto. Such machinery or towing vehicle shall be
- 26 equipped with reflector lights, front and rear, and a blinking
- 27 light clearly visible from the front and rear; \* \* \*
- 28 (e) Any machinery or equipment intended to be used for
- 29 normal farm purposes only and being delivered by an equipment
- 30 dealer to a customer, having a width in excess of the maximum
