1	AN ACT TO REQUIRE ANY PERSON WHO PLANS TO CONSTRUCT A
2	TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER IN AN UNINCORPORATED AREA TO PROVIDE
3	NOTICE BY CERTIFIED MAIL TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND TO
4	ADJACENT LANDOWNERS; TO REQUIRE SUCH PERSONS TO GIVE NOTICE BY
5	PUBLICATION; TO PROVIDE CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE
6	ACT: AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, unless the context 9 clearly requires otherwise:
- 10 (a) Residential dwelling means a building used or
- 11 intended to be used as a personal residence by the owner,
- 12 part-time owner or lessee of the building, or any person
- 13 authorized by such a person to use the building as a personal
- 14 residence.
- 15 (b) Telecommunications tower means any free-standing
- 16 structure, or any structure to be attached to a building or other
- 17 structure, that is proposed to be owned or principally used by a
- 18 public utility engaged in the provision of telecommunications
- 19 services.
- 20 (2) Any person who plans to construct a telecommunications
- 21 tower in an unincorporated area shall provide both of the
- 22 following by certified mail:
- 23 (a) Written notice to the board of supervisors in which
- 24 the tower is proposed to be constructed and to each owner of
- 25 property, as shown on the county's current tax list, whose land is
- 26 contiguous to or directly across a street or roadway from the
- 27 property on which the tower is proposed to be constructed. If the
- 28 notice to the board of supervisors or to a property owner is
- 29 returned unclaimed or refused, the person shall mail the notice by

- 30 regular mail. The failure of delivery of the notice does not
- 31 invalidate the notice. Such notice shall state all of the
- 32 following in clear and concise language:
- 33 (i) The person's intent to construct the tower;
- 34 and
- 35 (ii) A description of the property sufficient to
- 36 identify the proposed location.
- 37 (b) Written notice of the information specified in
- 38 paragraph (a) of this subsection to any owner of, or any person
- 39 occupying, a residential dwelling located within one hundred (100)
- 40 feet from telecommunications tower. If the notice is returned
- 41 unclaimed or refused, the person shall mail the notice by regular
- 42 mail. The failure of delivery of the notice does not invalidate
- 43 the notice.
- 44 (3) Any person who plans to construct a telecommunications
- 45 tower in an unincorporated area shall give notice thereof by
- 46 publication. Such notice shall be published for three (3) weeks
- 47 in a newspaper published in the county in which the proposed tower
- 48 is to be constructed, or in a county having a general circulation
- 49 in such county, and shall contain the information specified in
- 50 paragraph (a) of subsection (2).
- 51 (4) Any person who violates the provisions of this section
- 52 may upon conviction be subject to a fine not exceeding Five
- 53 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per violation or imprisonment in the
- 54 county jail not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both fine and
- 55 imprisonment.
- 56 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 57 and after July 1, 2002.
