FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 2684

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF HIGHWAYS IN COAHOMA,
2 DESOTO, CARROLL, KEMPER AND PANOLA COUNTIES AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND
3 TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI
4 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR MAINTENANCE WHENEVER THE COMMISSION
5 CERTIFIES THAT SUCH SEGMENTS HAVE BEEN BROUGHT UP TO COMMISSION
6 STANDARDS AND ALL UTILITIES, SIGNS, STRUCTURES AND OTHER
7 ENCROACHMENTS ON SUCH HIGHWAY AND RIGHT-OF-WAY, ARE REMOVED OR
8 RELOCATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

10 **SECTION 1.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
11 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
12 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
13 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
14 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
15 the state highway system of Mississippi:

16 **Northern District - Coahoma County:**

17 That segment of highway beginning Six-tenths (.6) of a
18 mile east of the termination of state maintenance of
19 Mississippi Highway 316 and extending northwesterly to
20 its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway
21 61, and that segment of highway extending westerly from
22 its intersection with U.S. Highway 49 and U.S. Highway
23 61 to its intersection with the eastern city limits of
24 Friars Point, Mississippi.

25 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
26 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
27 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
28 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
29 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all



30 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
31 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

32 **SECTION 2.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
33 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
34 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
35 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
36 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
37 the state highway system of Mississippi:

38 **Northern District - DeSoto County:**

39 That segment of road beginning at the intersection of
40 Mississippi 301 and Mississippi 304 and extending southerly
41 to Arkabutla Dam.

42 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
43 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
44 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
45 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
46 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
47 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
48 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

49 **SECTION 3.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
50 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
51 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
52 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
53 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
54 the state highway system of Mississippi:

55 **Northern District - Carroll County:**

56 Old Mississippi Highway 430 from the Leflore/Carroll
57 County line southeasterly to its intersection with
58 Mississippi Highway 17, a distance of approximately thirteen
59 (13) miles.

60 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
61 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
62 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this



63 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
64 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
65 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
66 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

67 **SECTION 4.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
68 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
69 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
70 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
71 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
72 the state highway system of Mississippi:

73 **Northern District - Kemper County:**

74 That portion of Old Highway 463 from Mississippi
75 Highway 16 northerly to Mississippi Highway 397.

76 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
77 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
78 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
79 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
80 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
81 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
82 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

83 **SECTION 5.** (1) The following highway is designated as a
84 state highway and placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
85 Transportation Commission; and such highway, together with the
86 highways designated in Section 65-3-3, and all other laws adding
87 links to the designated state highway system, are declared to be
88 the state highway system of Mississippi:

89 **Northern District - Panola County:**

90 Beginning at presently designated MS 315 in Section
91 30, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, thence
92 southeasterly to intersect MS 6 in Section 32,
93 Township 8 South, Range 5 West, being approximately
94 2.2 miles in length.



95 (2) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall take
96 over and assume responsibility for construction and maintenance of
97 the segment of highway described under subsection (1) of this
98 section whenever the commission certifies that such segment of
99 highway has been brought up to commission standards and all
100 utilities, signs, structures and other encroachments on such
101 highway and right-of-way, are removed or relocated.

102 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
103 and after July 1, 2002.
