## SENATE BILL NO. 2782

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 59-21-85, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REMOVE THE EXEMPTION FROM BOATING CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENT IF 2 3 RENTING BOAT FROM PERSON ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF RENTING BOATS; 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 59-21-85, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 59-21-85. (1) (a) No motorboat required to be numbered 8
- 9 under this chapter shall be operated by any person who is under
- the age of twelve (12) years, unless he possesses a certificate as 10
- required under this section and is also accompanied by a parent, 11
- guardian or other person who is at least twenty-one (21) years of 12
- 13 age and qualified and capable of operating the same.
- A motorboat required to be numbered under this 14
- chapter may not be operated by any person born after June 30, 15
- 1980, unless the person has completed a course in boating safety 16
- 17 conducted or approved by the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and
- Parks, and the person has in his immediate possession while 18
- operating a motorboat a certificate of satisfactory completion of 19
- the boating safety course. 20
- The requirement of possessing a certificate under 21
- this subsection shall not apply to any person operating a 22
- motorboat that is rented from a person engaged in the business of 23
- renting motorboats. This paragraph (c) shall repeal on July 1, 24
- 25 2002.
- 26 (2) Boating safety courses shall be held by the Department
- of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, or instructors designated and 27

28 approved by the department. The Department of Wildlife, Fisheries

- 29 and Parks shall issue a certificate to each person who
- 30 satisfactorily completes the boating safety course.
- 31 (3) In lieu of any other penalties provided for a violation
- 32 of this chapter, a violation of this section is punishable by a
- 33 fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than
- 34 Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).
- 35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 36 and after its passage.
