SENATE BILL NO. 2925

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-1-39, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 EXTEND THE REPEALER ON THE MUNICIPAL CRIME PREVENTION FUND; AND
3 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 45-1-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:

7 45-1-39. (1) There is created within the State Treasury a
8 special fund to be known as the Municipal Crime Prevention Fund.
9 The Department of Public Safety shall distribute monies out of the
10 fund to each municipality in this state on a per capita basis,
11 using the population figures from the most recent federal
12 decennial census; however, no municipality shall receive less than
13 Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) from the fund. Funds received
14 by municipalities under this section may be expended for, without
15 limitation, any of the following purposes:

- 16 (a) Law enforcement;
- 17 (b) Equipment, technology, supplies, contractual
18 services, including training and related travel, and commodities;
- 19 (c) State or federal crime prevention grant matching
20 requirements; and
- 21 (d) Any crime prevention programs implemented by more
22 than one (1) jurisdiction, which may include the State of
23 Mississippi and any of its agencies, departments or political
24 subdivisions, through the use of interlocal cooperation
25 agreements.

26 (2) This section shall stand repealed on June 30, 2005.



27 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
28 and after its passage.
