6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State
9	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
10	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management
11	Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et
12	seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning
13	July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003 \$ 760,176.00.
14	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
15	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
16	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
17	Emergency Management Agency which is comprised of special source
18	funds collected by or otherwise available to the agency, for the
19	support and maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year
20	beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
21	\$ 4,877,675.00.
22	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
23	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall

- 86 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 87 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency may, upon
- 88 the request of a local public emergency management organization in
- 89 an area which has suffered a natural disaster, supply equipment to
- 90 rural water associations to enable their continued operation when
- 91 the local emergency management organization determines that such
- 92 private entities provide services essential to the welfare of the
- 93 community.

213	July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003 \$ 1,973,445.00.
214	SECTION 21. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
215	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
216	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Emergency Management
217	Agency Fund Nos. 3725, 3724 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying
218	certain administrative expenses and the state and federal share of
219	the cost of the Public Assistance Program, the Individual and
220	Family Grant Program and the Hazard Mitigation Program resulting
221	from the tornado disasters in November 2001, for the fiscal year
222	beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003
223	\$ 4,981,646.00.

224	SECTION 22. The funds appropriated in Section 6 shall be
225	expended only as provided in Sections 43-41-1 et seq. and
226	43-41-301 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, or for the purpose of
227	matching federal funds in the event a disaster occurs within the
228	state.
229	SECTION 23. The expenditure of the funds appropriated by
230	this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be
231	paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General
232	Fund not otherwise appropriated, or the proper special funds, upon
233	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
234	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
235	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
236	SECTION 24. This act shall take effect and be in force from
237	and after July 1, 2002.
