SENATE BILL NO. 3190

1	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF
2	GREENWOOD, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONSTRUCT, ACQUIRE, MAINTAIN, OPERATE
3	AND PROVIDE RAILROAD PROPERTY AND FACILITIES WITHIN OR WITHOUT THE
4	CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO LEASE,
5	RENT, SELL OR EXCHANGE ANY OR ALL RAILROAD PROPERTIES AND
6	FACILITIES ACQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT; TO AUTHORIZE
7	THE CITY TO SELL, RENT OR LEASE PROPERTY TO THE COLUMBUS &
8	GREENVILLE RAILROAD IN EXCHANGE FOR PROPERTY OF SUCH RAILROAD
9	LOCATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY; TO AUTHORIZE THE
10	CITY TO ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL
11	AMOUNT OF \$3,000,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS ACT; AND FOR
12	RELATED PURPOSES.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 14 **SECTION 1.** As used in this act:
- 15 (a) "City" means the City of Greenwood, Mississippi.
- 16 (b) "Railroad property and facilities" has the meaning 17 ascribed to such term in Section 19-29-5.
- 18 **SECTION 2.** The governing authorities of the city are hereby
- 19 authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to construct,
- 20 acquire, maintain, operate and provide railroad properties and
- 21 facilities within or without the corporate limits of the city and
- 22 to acquire suitable land for the location of such railroad
- 23 properties and facilities.
- 24 SECTION 3. (1) The governing authorities of the city are
- 25 authorized and empowered to lease, rent, sell or exchange any or
- 26 all railroad properties and facilities acquired under the
- 27 provisions of this act to any person, firm, association or
- 28 corporation for railroad or industrial purposes, under such terms
- 29 and conditions as the governing authorities deem proper, and any
- 30 such disposition may be made at public or private sale. In
- 31 disposing of such railroad property and facilities under this act,

- 32 any provisions of Section 21-17-1 regarding the disposition of
- 33 municipal property shall not apply.
- 34 (2) The governing authorities of the city are authorized and
- 35 empowered, in their discretion to sell, lease or rent to the
- 36 Columbus & Greenville Railroad properties acquired under this act
- 37 in exchange for railroad properties and facilities of the Columbus
- 38 & Greenville Railroad located within the corporate limits of the
- 39 city.
- 40 **SECTION 4.** The city may accept federal funds or funds from
- 41 the Mississippi Department of Transportation to carry out the
- 42 provisions of this act. All federal funds or funds from the
- 43 Mississippi Department of Transportation received under the
- 44 provisions of this act shall be expended for the purposes set
- 45 forth in the funding agreement.
- 46 **SECTION 5.** For the purpose of providing funds to defray the
- 47 expense of acquiring railroad properties and facilities and the
- 48 expense of improving such property, the governing authorities of
- 49 the city are authorized and empowered to issue general obligation
- 50 bonds in an amount not to exceed an aggregate principal amount of
- 51 Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00).
- 52 **SECTION 6.** The general obligation bonds issued under the
- 53 provisions of this act shall not be subject to the twenty percent
- 54 (20%) debt limitation set forth in Section 21-33-303. Except as
- 55 otherwise provided in this act, all bonds issued under the
- 56 provisions of this act shall be issued and the proceeds managed in
- 57 accordance with the provisions of Sections 21-33-301 et seq.
- 58 **SECTION 7**. This act, without reference to any other statute
- 59 not referred to herein, shall be deemed to be full and complete
- 60 authority for the borrowing of money and the issuing of bonds as
- 61 authorized by the governing authorities and shall be construed as
- 62 an additional and alternate method therefor.
- 63 **SECTION 8.** Any bonds issued under the provisions of this act
- 64 shall be validated in the manner provided by law.

65 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

66 and after its passage.
