SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 553

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING DR.
2 JANET HENDERSON UPON THE OCCASION OF BEING NAMED THE SOUTHERN
3 ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGES AND SCHOOLS 2001 DISTINGUISHED EDUCATOR.

4 WHEREAS, Dr. Henderson has been honored by the Southern
5 Association of Colleges and Schools as the "2001 Distinguished
6 Educator"; and

7 WHEREAS, Dr. Janet Henderson currently serves as Assistant
8 Superintendent of Education for Curriculum and Instruction in the
9 Starkville School District; and

10 WHEREAS, the former teacher and Overstreet Elementary
11 Principal, Dr. Henderson now serves as the assistant
12 superintendent for curriculum and instructions for the school
13 district, as chairperson of the Southern Association of Colleges
14 and Schools Mississippi Elementary Committee and on the SACS
15 Executive Council and Standards Committee; and

16 WHEREAS, Dr. Henderson has over 32 years of involvement with
17 this accreditation organization which has continued to raise the
18 bar in educational standards throughout the Southeastern United
19 States. The current school improvement process required for SACS
20 accreditation represents the best of current research in
21 education; and

22 WHEREAS, during her tenure as Principal at Overstreet School,
23 the school was named Best of State in "Redbook" magazine's
24 America's Best Project; and

25 WHEREAS, she has been recognized by the Starkville Chamber of
26 Commerce in the Education Hall of Fame, named a Mississippi
27 Administrator of the Year finalist and has served as President of



28 the Mississippi Association of School Administrators and the
29 Mississippi State University Phi Delta Kappa Chapter, where she
30 earned her bachelor of science, master's and doctorate degree; and

31 WHEREAS, serving as a facilitator for school improvement in
32 several school districts, Dr. Henderson has also participated in
33 several self-studies, implemented a district's kindergarten
34 program, has aided in the merger of two elementary schools and
35 implemented the school renewal process; and

36 WHEREAS, she has brought honor to her school district, her
37 community and to the State of Mississippi, and it is the policy of
38 this Legislature to recognize excellence and achievement of the
39 citizens of this state, especially when exhibited by those who
40 work with our young people, who are our future:

41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
42 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
43 we do hereby commend and congratulate Dr. Janet Henderson as the
44 recipient of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools 2001
45 Distinguished Educator Award, and wish her continued success in
46 her future professional and academic endeavors.
