SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 564

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING ANDREW
2 CARY YOUNG OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, WINNER OF THE 2000 GOVERNOR'S
3 EXCELLENCE IN THE ARTS AWARD IN THE CATEGORY OF ARTIST
4 ACHIEVEMENT.

5 WHEREAS, Andrew is a native Mississippian, raised in Jackson.
6 He graduated from LSU with a degree in Landscape Architecture.
7 Returning home in 1975, he established Pearl River Glass Studio
8 with the idea of applying his special training as a designer to
9 his chosen career as an artist in glass; and

10 WHEREAS, Andrew has dedicated his career to the idea that
11 stained glass is the most expressive of artistic media. An
12 integral part of the execution of his artwork has been the
13 successful collaboration with members of Pearl River Glass Studio.
14 He received the Grant to Individual Artists from the Mississippi
15 Arts Commission in 1987. He has studied with German glass artists
16 Ludwig Schaffrath and Hans Gotfried von Stockhausen, and since
17 1996, Andrew has studied with Russian master iconographer
18 Vladislav Adrejev; and

19 WHEREAS, Andrew's designs in stained glass have recently been
20 completed by PRGS for St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church,
21 Madison, and St. Peter's by the Sea Episcopal Church, Gulfport,
22 First United Methodist Church, Tupelo and the Paris-Yates Chapel,
23 University of Mississippi, Oxford; and

24 WHEREAS, Andrew served on the board of the Arts Alliance of
25 Jackson/Hinds County, the Craftsman's Guild of Mississippi, and
26 Millsaps Arts and Lecture Series. He presently serves on the
27 Board of Directors of the North Mid-town Community Development
28 Corporation and the Stained Glass Association of America. He was



29 recently elected Second Vice President of the SGAA. His work has
30 been exhibited at the Mississippi Museum of Art, Canadian Clay and
31 Glass Gallery and Pearl River/Studio Gallery; and

32 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the
33 inspiration and talent of this Mississippian who has brought honor
34 to his craft, his community and to the State of Mississippi:

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
36 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
37 we do hereby commend and congratulate Andrew Cary Young of
38 Jackson, Mississippi, winner of the 2002 Governor's Excellence in
39 the Arts Award in the category of Artist Achievement, and wish him
40 and his family continued success in his future artistic endeavors.

42 Andrew Young on February 15, 2002, at the Governor's Excellence in
