SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 613

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE MOST REVEREND WILLIAM
2 HOUCK UPON THE OCCASION OF THE GOLDEN JUBILEE OF HIS ORDINATION TO
3 THE PRIESTHOOD OF THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH.

4 WHEREAS, the Reverend Bishop William Houck was ordained to
5 the Priesthood of the Roman Catholic Church on May 19, 1951, and
6 celebrated his Golden Jubilee on May 29, 2001; and

7 WHEREAS, Bishop Houck was installed as the Bishop of the
8 Diocese of Jackson in the State of Mississippi on July 5, 1984,
9 having served as auxiliary since 1979; and

10 WHEREAS, the Bishop serves as the head of Catholic Charities
11 for Mississippi, overseeing all of the charitable activities of
12 the Diocese of Jackson; and

13 WHEREAS, the Bishop's leadership in the civic and charitable
14 activities of his city and state are a matter of record, and it is
15 with great pride that we recognize the service of this citizen who
16 has brought honor to the State of Mississippi:

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
18 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
19 we do hereby commend the many years of service that the Reverend
20 Bishop William Houck has given to the people of Mississippi on the
21 occasion of the Golden Jubilee of his Ordination to the Priesthood
22 of the Roman Catholic Church and of his 22 years of service as the
23 Bishop of the Diocese of Jackson, Mississippi.
