SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 619

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO AMEND HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION  
2 NO. 127, 2002 REGULAR SESSION, TO SPECIFY CERTAIN ADDITIONAL  
3 CONDITIONS UPON WHICH THE HOUSE AND SENATE WILL RECONVENE AND TO  
4 FIX THE DATE OF SINE DIE ADJOURNMENT OF THE 2002 REGULAR SESSION  
5 OF THE LEGISLATURE AT 5:00 P.M. FRIDAY, APRIL 19, 2002.

6 **SECTION 1.** House Concurrent Resolution No. 127, 2002 Regular  
7 Session, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 WHEREAS, Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of 1890,  
9 provides that the House of Representatives, by resolution with the  
10 Senate concurring therein, and by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those  
11 present and voting in each house, may extend a regular session of  
12 the Legislature for a period of thirty (30) days; and

13 WHEREAS, the Legislature has determined that it wishes to  
14 have the opportunity to consider, during the 2002 Regular Session,  
15 certain bills passed by the Legislature at the 2002 Regular  
16 Session that the Governor may veto, without having to remain  
17 continuously in session while the Governor has those bills under  
18 consideration; and

19 WHEREAS, the Legislature has determined that it wishes to  
20 have the opportunity to consider, during the 2002 Regular Session,  
21 any specific legislative proposals of the Governor relating to the  
22 operation of the Mississippi Medicaid Program in fiscal year 2003;  
23 and

24 WHEREAS, Section 57 of the Mississippi Constitution of 1890  
25 prohibits the adjourning of either house for more than three (3)  
26 days without the consent of the other house, and the Legislature  
27 has determined that a period of adjournment of more than three (3)  
28 days may be necessary:



29           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
30 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING  
31 THEREIN, That the 2002 Regular Session of the Legislature is  
32 extended for a period of thirty (30) days from the final day of  
33 the ninety (90) calendar days of the 2002 Regular Session of the  
34 Legislature, under the provisions of Section 36, Mississippi  
35 Constitution of 1890.

36           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives and  
37 the Senate each may stand adjourned for a period of more than  
38 three (3) days from such date and time as determined by each  
39 respective house and, \* \* \* the House and Senate shall reconvene  
40 at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, April 19, 2002, for the purpose of only  
41 considering any legislation proposed by the Governor relating to  
42 the operation of the Mississippi Medicaid Program, otherwise, the  
43 House and Senate shall not reconvene.

44           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the 2002 Regular Session of the  
45 Legislature will stand adjourned sine die at 5:00 p.m., Friday,  
46 April 19, 2002.

47           **SECTION 2.** This concurrent resolution shall take effect and  
48 be in force from and after its passage.
