- 5 WHEREAS, Coach Jerry Boatner, long-time Coach of West
- 6 Lauderdale High School, has been selected for induction into the
- 7 Mississippi Association of Coaches Hall of Fame, Class of 2002;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, Jerry Boatner, at age 56, is entering his 29th year
- 10 as head coach of the Knights. In Coach Boatner's previous 28
- 11 years, he has led the black and red to an overall record of 757
- 12 wins and 245 losses. Included in this number are 13 conference
- 13 championships, 10 state titles, three state runner-up titles, 20
- 14 district championships and 21 invitational championships; and
- WHEREAS, In 1993 and 2001, Coach Boatner was named
- 16 Coach-of-the-Year by the National High School Coaches of America
- 17 for District Six which includes Alabama, Mississippi, Missouri,
- 18 Arkansas, Texas and Oklahoma. The National High School Baseball
- 19 Coaches also awarded him Groundskeeper-of-the-Year in 1992 and
- 20 1993. Coach Boatner was chosen in 1992 as Baseball
- 21 Coach-of-the-Year by the United States Baseball Federation. He
- 22 has been named Conference Coach-of-the-Year 13 times and Area
- 23 Coach-of-the-Year eight times. In 1994, he was chosen to coach
- 24 the South Central Team in the State Games. In 1978 and 1990, he
- 25 was honored by the Mississippi Association of Coaches as
- 26 Coach-of-the-Year. In 1976 and 1996, hw was chosen as the South
- 27 Coach for the Mississippi High School All-Star Baseball Game. He
- 28 has also received an award from Delta State University for

- 29 coaching achievement. Coach Boatner's 757 wins at West
- 30 Lauderdale, along with 50 wins at Clarkdale, makes him the second
- 31 winningest baseball coach in Mississippi and the eighth in the
- 32 nation. He received the Wayne Twink Seyton Award in 1966 for
- 33 Unselfish Love of Baseball. In 1990, he received the Clarion
- 34 Ledger Coach-of-the-Year. He was inducted into Delta State
- 35 University Alumni Coaches' Hall of Fame in 1998. In 1999 he was
- 36 inducted into Crossroad Diamond Baseball Club's Hall of Fame; and
- 37 WHEREAS, one of the greatest honors bestowed upon Coach
- 38 Boatner was when the people of Clarkdale High School named their
- 39 baseball field in his honor in 1973. More recently, in 1992 and
- 40 1993, his West Lauderdale baseball field was named
- 41 Field-of-the-Year by the National High School Baseball Coaches;
- 42 and
- WHEREAS, Coach Boatner is a 1963 graduate of Meridian High
- 44 School where he earned eight letters--three in baseball, three in
- 45 track and two in basketball. While attending East Mississippi
- 46 Junior College, he lettered four more times -- two in baseball and
- 47 two in basketball. He was also a member of the State Champion
- 48 Junior College baseball team in 1965. He is a graduate of Delta
- 49 State University where he was a two-year letterman in baseball and
- 50 a member of the 1968 baseball team that finished third in the
- 51 College World Series. He earned a Master's Degree in Education at
- 52 Delta State in 1971. In 1980, he earned his Education Specialist
- 53 Degree from Mississippi State University. He is a member of
- 54 Mississippi Association of Coaches, National High School Baseball
- 55 Coaches Association and the American Baseball Coaches Association.
- 56 He serves as State Chairman for the United States Baseball
- 57 Federation, and is an associate scout for the Kansas City Royals;
- 58 and
- 59 WHEREAS, in 1990, he was named Head Softball Coach. In these
- 60 11 years, he has compiled a record of 432 wins and only 91 losses.
- 61 Included in these wins are eight district championships, four

- 62 South State championships, one South State runner-up, five State
- 63 championships, three State runners-up, and 15 Invitational
- 64 championships. Coach Boatner was chosen Softball
- 65 Coach-of-the-Year and All-Star Coach in 1998 by the Mississippi
- 66 Association of Coaches and Lauderdale County Coach-of-the-Year in
- 67 1993, 1994, 1996 and 1997; and
- 68 WHEREAS, Coach Jerry Boatner and wife, Marsha Jo, have two
- 69 children and four grandchildren. They are members of First
- 70 Baptist Church in Collinsville; and
- 71 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this
- 72 outstanding coach who has brought honor to his school, his
- 73 community and to the State of Mississippi:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 75 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Coach
- 76 Jerry Boatner of West Lauderdale High School, upon his induction
- 77 into the Mississippi Association of Coaches Hall of Fame Class of
- 78 2002, and wish him and his family continued success in all their
- 79 future endeavors.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be presented to
- 81 Coach Boatner at induction ceremonies to be held on July 12, 2002,
- 82 in Clinton, Mississippi, and be made available to the Capitol
- 83 Press Corps.
