SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 22

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING ANDREW CARY YOUNG
2 OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, WINNER OF THE 2002 GOVERNOR'S EXCELLENCE
3 IN THE ARTS AWARD IN THE CATEGORY OF ARTIST ACHIEVEMENT.

4 WHEREAS, Andrew is a native Mississippian, raised in Jackson.
5 He graduated from LSU with a degree in Landscape Architecture.
6 Returning home in 1975, he established Pearl River Glass Studio
7 with the idea of applying his special training as a designer to
8 his chosen career as an artist in glass; and

9 WHEREAS, Andrew has dedicated his career to the idea that
10 stained glass is the most expressive of artistic media. An
11 integral part of the execution of his artwork has been the
12 successful collaboration with members of Pearl River Glass Studio.
13 He received the Grant to Individual Artists from the Mississippi
14 Arts Commission in 1987. He has studied with German glass artists
15 Ludwig Schaffrath and Hans Gotfried von Stockhausen, and since
16 1996, Andrew has studied with Russian master iconographer
17 Vladislav Adrejev; and

18 WHEREAS, Andrew's designs in stained glass have recently been
19 completed by PRGS for St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church,
20 Madison, and St. Peter's by the Sea Episcopal Church, Gulfport,
21 First United Methodist Church, Tupelo and the Paris-Yates Chapel,
22 University of Mississippi, Oxford; and

23 WHEREAS, Andrew served on the board of the Arts Alliance of
24 Jackson/Hinds County, the Craftsman's Guild of Mississippi, and
25 Millsaps Arts and Lecture Series. He presently serves on the
26 Board of Directors of the North Mid-town Community Development
27 Corporation and the Stained Glass Association of America. He was



28 recently elected Second Vice President of the SGAA. His work has
29 been exhibited at the Mississippi Museum of Art, Canadian Clay and
30 Glass Gallery and Pearl River/Studio Gallery; and

31 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the
32 inspiration and talent of this Mississippian who has brought honor
33 to his craft, his community and to the State of Mississippi:

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
35 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Andrew
36 Cary Young of Jackson, Mississippi, winner of the 2002 Governor's
37 Excellence in the Arts Award in the category of Artist
38 Achievement, and wish him and his family continued success in his
39 future artistic endeavors.
