REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2249: Physical education classes K-9; express legislative intent.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. Section 37-13-133, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 15 amended as follows:
- 16 37-13-133. <u>Under</u> the provisions of Section 37-13-131, the
- 17 State Department of Education <u>may</u> provide for the services of a
- 18 School Health Services Coordinator, School Instruction
- 19 Coordinator, School Environmental Specialist, * * * and such other
- 20 professional and nonprofessional staff as may be needed and as
- 21 funds available to the department will permit. The State
- 22 <u>Department of Education, subject to the availability of funds</u>
- 23 specifically for such purpose, shall employ a physical activity
- 24 coordinator K-12 not later than sixty (60) days after receipt of
- 25 <u>such funds</u>, in accordance with the provisions of Section
- 26 <u>37-13-134.</u> It shall be the responsibility of <u>that</u> professional
- 27 staff to coordinate efforts of the personnel of the State
- 28 Department of Education, the state's colleges and universities,
- 29 local public schools and other appropriate agencies to provide the
- 30 comprehensive health education curriculum.
- 31 **SECTION 2.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 32 37-13-134, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 33 37-13-134. (1) The Legislature recognizes that there is a
- 34 problem with Mississippi student inactivity and obesity in the
- 35 elementary school years, and therefore recommends the following

- 36 guidelines for school district physical education and fitness
- 37 classes: Grades Kindergarten through Six: thirty (30) minutes
- 38 per day; Grades Seven through Nine: two (2) hours per week.
- 39 (2) Until such time that state-source funds can be
- 40 appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 41 State Department of Education make application for any federal
- 42 funds available to implement this recommendation and to employ a
- 43 physical activity coordinator.
- 44 (3) The physical activity coordinator employed under Section
- 45 37-13-133 must have the qualifications prescribed in any of the
- 46 following paragraphs, which are listed in the order of preference:
- 47 (a) A doctorate in physical education, exercise science
- 48 or a highly related field, and at least three (3) years of
- 49 experience in teaching physical education in grades K-12 or in
- 50 physical activity promotion/fitness leadership; or
- 51 (b) A master's degree in physical education, exercise
- 52 science or a highly related field, and at least five (5) years of
- 53 experience in teaching physical education in grades K-12 or in
- 54 physical activity promotion/fitness leadership; or
- 55 (c) A bachelor's degree in physical education, a
- 56 teacher's license, and at least seven (7) years of experience in
- 57 teaching physical education in grades K-12 or in physical activity
- 58 promotion/fitness leadership.
- 59 (4) The Governor's Commission on Physical Fitness and Sports
- 60 created under Section 7-1-551 et seq., the Mississippi Council on
- Obesity Prevention and Management created under Section 41-101-1
- 62 et seq., the Task Force on Heart Disease and Stroke Prevention
- 63 created under Section 41-103-1 et seq., the Mississippi Alliance
- 64 for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance, and the
- 65 Mississippi Alliance for School Health shall provide
- 66 recommendations to the State Department of Education regarding the
- 67 employment of the physical activity coordinator. The department
- 68 shall consider the recommendations of those entities in employing
- 69 the physical activity coordinator.
- 70 (5) The physical activity coordinator shall present a state
- 71 physical activity plan each year to the Governor's Commission on

- 72 Physical Fitness and Sports, the Mississippi Council on Obesity
- 73 Prevention and Management, the Task Force on Heart Disease and
- 74 Stroke Prevention, and the Mississippi Alliance for School Health.
- 75 (6) The physical activity coordinator shall monitor the
- 76 districts for adherence to current Mississippi school
- 77 accountability standards and for implementation of the physical
- 78 education curriculum on file with the State Department of
- 79 Education.
- 80 (7) The State Department of Education shall conduct a study
- 81 on the correlation between physical activity or exercise and
- 82 classroom performance. The study must include recommendations for
- 83 the implementation of a healthy schools program. The department
- 84 shall submit a report on the results of the study, including
- 85 recommendations for legislation, to the chairmen of the Education
- 86 Committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate before
- 87 December 1, 2002.
- 88 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 89 and after July 1, 2002.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	QUALIFICATIONS OF THE PHYSICAL ACTIVITY COORDINATOR; TO REQUIRE
8	THE PHYSICAL ACTIVITY COORDINATOR TO PRESENT A STATE PHYSICAL
9	ACTIVITY PLAN EACH YEAR; TO REQUIRE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF
10	EDUCATION TO CONDUCT A STUDY AND SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE HOUSE AND
11	SENATE EDUCATION COMMITTEES ON THE CORRELATION BETWEEN PHYSICAL
12	ACTIVITY AND CLASSROOM PERFORMANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
