- SECTION 1. Section 37-13-133, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 20 amended as follows: 2.1 <u>Under</u> the provisions of Section 37-13-131, the 22 37-13-133. 2.3 State Department of Education may provide for the services of a School Health Services Coordinator, School Instruction 24 Coordinator, School Environmental Specialist, * * * and such other 2.5 professional and nonprofessional staff as may be needed and as 26 funds available to the department will permit.
