| 28 | feet; thence South 69°50'07" East, 42.18 feet; thence |
| 29 | North 00°41'05" East, 341.68 feet; thence North |
| 30 | 52°41'26" West, 173.82 feet along said south |
| 31 | right-of-way line of Mississippi Highway 184 to the |
| 32 | point of beginning. Said parcel containing 0.48 acres ± |
| 33 | more or less and being situated in the NW $1/4$ of the NW |

- 35 Mississippi.
- 36 (2) The sale and conveyance authorized in this section may
- 37 be made on such terms and conditions agreed upon by the Department
- 38 of Finance and Administration and the Board of Supervisors of
- 39 Lincoln County, Mississippi, to be in the best interests of both
- 40 parties.
- 41 (3) Any proceeds from the sale and conveyance of the real
- 42 property described in subsection (1) of this section shall be used
- 43 first to reimburse the Department of Finance and Administration
- 44 for any costs incurred by the department regarding the sale and
- 45 conveyance, and the remaining proceeds shall be deposited into the
- 46 State General Fund.
- 47 (4) The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral rights
- 48 to the real property sold and conveyed pursuant to this section.
- 49 **SECTION 2.** (1) The Department of Finance and
- 50 Administration, acting on behalf of the Mississippi Forestry
- 51 Commission, may grant a temporary construction easement to the
- 52 Board of Supervisors of Lincoln County, Mississippi, over and
- 53 across certain state owned real property located in Lincoln
- 54 County, Mississippi, being more particularly described as follows:
- Beginning at the intersection of the North boundary line
- of Section 21, Township 7 North, Range 8 East, Lincoln
- County, Mississippi, with the South right-of-way line of
- Mississippi Hwy 184 (formerly U.S. Highway 84) and the

- 70 (2) The temporary construction easement authorized in this
- 71 section may be made on such terms and conditions agreed upon by
- 72 the Department of Finance and Administration and the Board of
- 73 Supervisors of Lincoln County, Mississippi, to be in the best
- 74 interests of both parties.
- 75 **SECTION 3.** (1) The Mississippi Department of Wildlife,
- 76 Fisheries and Parks, acting through the Department of Finance and
- 77 Administration, shall convey to the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post
- 78 9122, a parcel of state-owned property situated in Simpson County,
- 79 Mississippi, being more particularly described as follows:
- 80 Commence at the NE Corner of the SW/4 of the NE/4
- 81 Section 21, Township 1 North, Range 5 East, Simpson
- 82 County, Mississippi, and run thence South 01° 39' W, 501
- ft. to the Point of Beginning for the lands herein
- 84 conveyed. From said Point of Beginning continue and run
- 85 South 809 ft. to the SE Corner of said SW/4 of the NE/4,
- 86 Section 21; run thence North 89° 02' W, 751.27 ft. to a
- point on the R.O.W. of the Northbound Lane of U.S.
- 88 Highway 49; run thence North 47° 16' W, 110.75 ft. to a
- 89 concrete marker; run North 55° 13' W, 186.82 ft. to a
- 90 concrete marker, continue North 34° 37' W, 156.08 ft. to
- 91 a concrete marker; thence continue to run along the
- 92 North R.O.W. line North 58° 00' W, 365 ft. to a point;
- 93 from said point run thence North 76° 30' E, 1381 ft. to
- 94 the Point of Beginning. All of said land lying and
- being situated in the SW/4 of the NE/4, Section 21,
- 96 Township 1 North, Range 5 East, Simpson County,
- 97 Mississippi, containing in the aggregate 20 acres, more
- or less, and less and except that parcel heretofore
- 99 conveyed to the V.F.W. Post 9122 as same is recorded in
- 100 Deed Book 919 at Page 672 of the Land Records located in
- 101 the Chancery Clerk's Office, Simpson County,
- 102 Mississippi.
- 103 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature that the real

- 104 property described in subsection (1) shall revert to the Veterans
- 105 of Foreign Wars, Post 9122, pursuant to the reverter clause of the
- 106 special warranty deed which granted the real property to the
- 107 Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks in 1961. Such
- 108 reverter clause provided that the real property shall revert back
- 109 to the grantors should it cease to be used for a public
- 110 recreational area and lake.
- 111 (3) The Department of Finance and Administration shall
- 112 require the real property described in subsection (1) to be
- 113 surveyed and marked. The Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post 9122,
- 114 shall pay all of the recording, survey and other expenses related
- 115 to the conveyance before the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and
- 116 Parks conveys the real property.
- 117 **SECTION 4.** Chapter 433, Laws of 2001, which authorizes the
- 118 Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks to convey
- 119 certain state-owned real property in Simpson County to the
- 120 Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 9122, is hereby repealed.
- 121 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 122 and after its passage.

- 7 REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN SIMPSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO THE
- 8 VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS POST 9122; TO REPEAL CHAPTER 433, LAWS OF
- 9 2001, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND
- 10 PARKS TO CONVEY CERTAIN STATE-OWNED REAL PROPERTY IN SIMPSON
- 11 COUNTY TO THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS POST 9122; AND FOR RELATED
- 12 PURPOSES.
