AMENDMENT No. 2 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill NO. 2003

1 **AMEND BY INSERTING THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENT AFTER LINE 162 AND**
2 **RENUMBERING:**

3 **SECTION 3.** Section 47-5-1207, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
4 amended as follows:

5 47-5-1207. (1) The State Prison Emergency Construction and
6 Management Board shall select a suitable site or sites for a
7 public or private facility not to exceed one thousand (1,000) beds
8 in any of the following counties: Lauderdale, Quitman, Perry and
9 Sharkey.

10 (2) The State Prison Emergency Construction and Management
11 Board may contract for the construction, lease, acquisition,
12 improvement, operation and management of a private correctional
13 facility in Marshall County * * * for the private incarceration of
14 not more than one thousand (1,000) state inmates at the facility.

15 (3) The State Prison Emergency Construction and Management
16 Board may contract with any county industrial or economic
17 development authority or district for the construction, lease,
18 acquisition, improvement, operation and management of a private
19 correctional facility to be sited or constructed under Laws, 1994
20 First Extraordinary Session, Ch. 26.

21 (4) The State Prison Emergency Construction and Management
22 Board may contract for the construction, lease, acquisition,
23 improvement and operation of two (2) private restitution centers,

24 one of which may be in Bolivar County. The capacity of each
25 restitution center shall not exceed seventy-five (75) state
26 inmates.

27 (5) (a) The State Prison Emergency Construction and
28 Management Board may contract for the special needs facility and
29 services authorized in Sections 47-5-1101 through 47-5-1123.

30 (b) No later than September 15, 1994, the Joint
31 Legislative Committee on Performance Evaluation and Expenditure
32 Review shall determine the state medical cost per inmate day to
33 use as a basis for measuring the validity of ten percent (10%)
34 savings of the contractor cost.

35 (6) Each private contractor and private facility housing
36 state inmates must meet the requirements of Section 47-5-1211
37 through Section 47-5-1227.

38 (7) No additional emergency prisons shall be located in any
39 city and/or county, except upon the submission to the State Prison
40 Emergency Construction and Management Board, of a resolution
41 signed by a majority of the governing authorities of the city
42 and/or county, wherein the proposed prison site is to be located,
43 approving and/or requesting that a prison facility be located at
44 the proposed site.
