HOUSE BILL NO. 326

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-541, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1

TO REQUIRE IDENTIFICATION OF ELECTORS BEFORE VOTING; TO REQUIRE

ELECTORS TO SHOW A DRIVER'S LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY OR OTHER FORM OF LEGAL 3

IDENTIFICATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6

7 SECTION 1. Section 23-15-541, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

amended as follows: 8

23-15-541. At all elections, the polls shall be opened at 9

seven o'clock in the morning and be kept open until seven o'clock 10

in the evening and no longer. Upon the opening of the polls, and 11

not before, the managers of the election shall designate two (2) 12

of their number, other than the manager previously designated to 13

14 receive the blank ballots, who shall * * * be known respectively

as the initialing manager and the alternate initialing manager. 15

The alternate initialing manager, in the absence of the initialing 16

manager, shall perform all of the duties and undertake all of the 17

responsibilities of the initialing manager. When any person 18

19 entitled to vote shall appear to vote, the managers shall identify

the voter, in the presence and view of the bystanders, by 20

requiring the voter to submit a valid Mississippi driver's 21

22 license, an identification card issued by the Department of Public

Safety, a voter registration card, a Medicaid or Medicare card, 23

health insurance card, tax receipt or other identification card or 24

by comparison with the descriptive information on the pollbook or 25

by having a person from the precinct vouch for the person's 26

identification; and then that person shall * * * sign his name in 27

a receipt book or booklet provided for that purpose and to be used 28

at that election only and the receipt book or booklet shall be used in lieu of the list made by the managers or clerks which 30 lists the voters who have voted formerly * * *; whereupon and not 31 before, the initialing manager or, in his absence, the alternate 32 33 initialing manager shall indorse his initials on the back of an 34 official blank ballot, prepared in accordance with law, and at such place on the back of the ballot that the initials may be seen 35 after the ballot has been marked and folded, and when so indorsed 36 he shall deliver it to the voter, which ballot the voter shall 37 mark in the manner provided by law, which when done the voter 38 shall deliver the same to the initialing manager or, in his 39 absence, to the alternate initialing manager, in the presence of 40 the others, and the manager shall see that the ballot so delivered 41 bears on the back thereof the genuine initials of the initialing 42 manager, or alternate initialing manager, and if so, but not 43 otherwise, the ballot shall be put into the ballot box; and when 44 45 so done one (1) of the managers or a duly appointed clerk shall make the proper entry on the pollbook. If the voter is unable to 46 write his name on the receipt book, a manager or clerk shall note 47 on the back of the ballot that it was receipted for by his 48 assistance. 49

requires voters to show identification before voting, is repealed. 51 The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi 52 SECTION 3. 53 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the 54 55 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 56 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 57 extended. 58

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 59 60 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting

Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended. 61
