## HOUSE BILL NO. 478

- AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI, MISSISSIPPI
  STATE UNIVERSITY, THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI AND
  JACKSON STATE UNIVERSITY TO PLAY FOOTBALL AGAINST EACH OTHER ON A
  ROTATING BASIS SO THAT EACH UNIVERSITY PLAYS THE OTHERS EVERY
  THREE YEARS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions
- 8 of Higher Learning shall require the University of Mississippi,
- 9 Mississippi State University, the University of Southern
- 10 Mississippi and Jackson State University to each compete in
- 11 football against another university named in this section every
- 12 year, beginning in the 2003 season. The games between these
- 13 universities shall rotate triennially so that each year during a
- 14 cycle of three (3) consecutive years, each school will compete
- 15 against a university other than the universities against which the
- 16 school competed during the preceding two (2) seasons.
- 17 (2) This section may not be construed to prohibit the
- 18 University of Mississippi, Mississippi State University, the
- 19 University of Southern Mississippi and Jackson State University
- 20 from competing against more than one (1) other university named in
- 21 this section during the same year.
- 22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2003.
