HOUSE BILL NO. 643

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-41, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 ALLOW ANTLERED DEER WITH LESS THAN FOUR POINTS TO BE TAKEN IF
- 3 NECESSARY TO MANAGE DEER ON DEER MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
- 4 LANDS AND WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREAS; TO REQUIRE A PERMIT TO TAKE
- 5 SUCH DEER; TO REQUIRE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE PROGRAM; AND FOR
- 6 RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 49-7-41. (1) The commission may set the bag limits for game
- 11 animals, birds and fish, unless the bag limits are established by
- 12 the Legislature by statute. This subsection shall stand repealed
- 13 on July 1, 2004.
- 14 (2) (a) The bag limit on antlered * * * deer is one
- 15 (1) * * * per day, not to exceed three (3) per license year. An
- 16 antlered * * * deer must have antlers of four (4) points or
- 17 greater to be taken except as provided in paragraph (b) of this
- 18 subsection.
- 19 (b) An antlered deer with less than four (4) points may
- 20 be taken by permit if it is necessary to manage deer on lands
- 21 under the deer management assistance program or wildlife
- 22 management areas. A written management justification issued by
- 23 the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks must accompany any
- 24 request for such a permit. Any antlered deer with less than four
- 25 (4) points harvested under this permit must be identified with a
- 26 tag immediately upon possession. Antlered deer taken by permit
- 27 shall be subject to the daily bag limit but shall not be subject
- 28 to the annual bag limit on antlered deer. The department shall

- 29 include a report on permits issued, to whom issued and deer
- 30 harvested in the department's annual deer program report.
- 31 (3) (a) The bag limit on antlerless deer is one (1)
- 32 per day, not to exceed three (3) per license year; except that two
- 33 (2) additional antlerless deer per license year may be taken with
- 34 a bow and arrow. Antlerless deer may be taken only in the areas
- 35 prescribed by order of the commission. It is illegal to take a
- 36 spotted fawn in any season.
- 37 (b) It is unlawful for a nonresident to kill an
- 38 antlerless deer except: (i) a nonresident may take antlerless
- 39 deer on lands that the title is vested in the nonresident or on
- 40 lands that the nonresident has leased the hunting and fishing
- 41 rights; or (ii) a nonresident who has a native son or daughter
- 42 nonresident lifetime sportsman license or a resident lifetime
- 43 sportsman license may take antlerless deer on private lands,
- 44 wildlife management areas or national wildlife refuges.
- 45 (4) The bag limit on antlerless deer set by this section
- 46 shall not apply to private lands under the deer management
- 47 assistance program or the fee-based antlerless program as approved
- 48 by the department.
- 49 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 50 and after July 1, 2003.
