HOUSE BILL NO. 1118

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 49-7-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO

EXEMPT RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE MISSISSIPPI NATIONAL GUARD WHO ARE

3 AT LEAST FIFTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF

4 PURCHASING OR HAVING IN HIS OR HER POSSESSION A HUNTING AND

5 FISHING LICENSE WHILE ENGAGED IN SUCH ACTIVITIES; AND FOR RELATED

6 PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

9 amended as follows:

10 49-7-5. (1) (a) Any resident, as defined in Section

11 49-7-3, upon application, shall receive a combination resident

12 hunting and fishing license for the sum of Seventeen Dollars

13 (\$17.00). Such license shall qualify the licensee to hunt under

14 this chapter all game and fowl, including deer and turkey, and to

15 fish in any county of the state.

16 (b) Any resident, as defined in Section 49-7-3, upon

17 application, shall receive a resident combination small game

18 hunting and fishing license for the sum of Thirteen Dollars

19 (\$13.00) together with the fee provided in Section 49-7-17 to the

20 office or agent issuing such license. Such hunting license shall

21 qualify the licensee to hunt and fish under this chapter all game

22 and fowl, except deer and turkey, in any county in the state.

23 (c) Any resident of the State of Mississippi, as

24 defined in Section 49-7-3, upon application, shall receive a

25 resident small game license, and for it shall pay the issuing

officer or agent the sum of Thirteen Dollars (\$13.00), together

27 with the fee provided in Section 49-7-17 to the officer or agent

28 issuing such license. Such hunting license shall qualify the

29 person holding the same to hunt under the provisions of this

30 chapter, and in season, all game and fowl, except deer and turkey,

- 31 in any county in the state.
- 32 (d) Any resident, as defined in Section 49-7-3, upon
- 33 application, shall receive a sportsman's license for the sum of
- 34 Thirty-two Dollars (\$32.00). Such license shall qualify the
- 35 licensee to hunt under this chapter all game and fowl, including
- 36 deer and turkey, and to fish as provided by law, in any county in
- 37 the state, and to hunt using primitive weapons and bow and arrow
- 38 in the manner provided by law. The commission may notify the
- 39 licensee of the expiration of his license, and the licensee may
- 40 renew the license by mailing the sum of Thirty-two Dollars
- 41 (\$32.00) to the commission. A licensee who has not renewed the
- 42 license within thirty (30) days after the expiration date shall be
- 43 removed from the commission's records, and the licensee must apply
- 44 to be placed on the renewal list.
- 45 (2) (a) Any resident citizen of the State of Mississippi
- 46 who has not reached the age of sixteen (16) years or who has
- 47 reached the age of sixty-five (65) years, or any resident citizen
- 48 who is blind, paraplegic, or a multiple amputee, or who has been
- 49 adjudged by the Veterans Administration as having a total
- 50 service-connected disability, or has been adjudged to be totally
- 51 disabled by the Social Security Administration, or is a retired
- 52 member of the Mississippi National Guard who is at least
- 53 fifty-five (55) years of age shall not be required to purchase or
- 54 have in his possession, a hunting or fishing license while engaged
- 55 in such activities. A person exempt by reason of total
- 56 service-connected disability, as adjudged by the Veterans
- 57 Administration or who has been adjudged to be totally disabled by
- 58 the Social Security Administration or who is blind, paraplegic or
- 59 a multiple amputee, shall have in their possession and on their
- 60 person proof of their age, residency, disability status or other
- 61 respective physical impairment while engaged in the activities of
- 62 hunting or fishing.

- (b) All exempt hunting and fishing licenses previously
- 64 issued for disabilities shall be null and void effective July 1,
- 65 1993.
- (c) The commission may offer a youth all-game hunting
- 67 and fishing license for exempt youths who have a hunter education
- 68 certificate and an all-game hunting and fishing license for other
- 69 persons exempted under paragraph (a). Youths and other exempt
- 70 persons shall not be required to purchase this license or have it
- 71 in possession while hunting or fishing. The commission may
- 72 establish a fee not to exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00) for such
- 73 licenses.
- 74 (3) No license shall be required of residents to hunt, fish
- 75 or trap on lands in which the record title is vested in such
- 76 person.
- 77 (4) Any person or persons exempt under this section from
- 78 procuring a license shall be subject to and must comply with all
- 79 other terms and provisions of this chapter.
- 80 (5) Any person authorized to issue any license under this
- 81 section may collect and retain for the issuance of each license
- 82 the additional fee authorized under Section 49-7-17.
- 83 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 84 and after July 1, 2003.
