## HOUSE BILL NO. 1218

1	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A FULL SCHOLARSHIP, KNOWN AS THE
2	AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP, FOR OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS WHO MEET THE
3	CRITERIA PRESCRIBED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS
4	OF HIGHER LEARNING; TO PROVIDE THAT ATHLETES HAVING LESS THAN A
5	FULL ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THIS
5	SCHOLARSHIP; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** There shall be a full scholarship, known as the
- 9 Ambassador Scholarship, which shall be awarded to students who are
- 10 not residents of Mississippi based on criteria prescribed by the
- 11 Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, which
- 12 shall include, without limitation, minimum ACT score, minimum SAT
- 13 score and minimum high school GPA. The scholarship is for four
- 14 (4) years as long as the student takes a full course load each
- 15 semester and maintains the minimum GPA for the institution where
- 16 the student attends. Members of athletic teams of an institution
- 17 who do not have an athletic scholarship or have less than a full
- 18 athletic scholarship shall be eligible to receive this
- 19 scholarship. The board shall adopt such rules and regulations as
- 20 may be necessary to implement the scholarship program established
- 21 under this section.
- 22 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2003.
