HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 130

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING OMARR
2 CONNER FOR HIS OUTSTANDING HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL CAREER.

3 WHEREAS, Omarr Conner, a resident of Macon, Mississippi, has
4 had an outstanding high school football career; and

5 WHEREAS, a senior at Noxubee County High School, Mr. Conner
6 has contributed to the Noxubee County Tigers' success, under the
7 guidance of Coach M.C. Miller, by dynamically playing the position
8 of quarterback; and

9 WHEREAS, during his senior year, Omarr Conner, accounted for
10 a total of 4,146 yards and a state-record 54 touchdowns and has
11 an astounding 9,506 total yards, and 110 touchdowns over his four
12 seasons, which includes 6,599 passing yards and 59 touchdown
13 passes while at Noxubee County High School; and

14 WHEREAS, Omarr Conner has been bestowed with several titles
15 including being named Mr. Football on the Clarion-Ledger All-State
16 team, named to the Clarion-Ledger's Dandy Dozen as one of the
17 state's top 12 prospects prior to his senior season and named to
18 the Atlanta Journal-Constitution Super Southern 100, which is a
19 list of the top 100 players in the South; and

20 WHEREAS, additional titles have been given to Mr. Conner,
21 including being named first-team, all-state at the quarterback
22 position by the Clarion-Ledger and being named by the Mississippi
23 Association of Coaches Class 4A Offensive Player of the Year,
24 Region 2-4A most valuable player and first-team, all-state in that
25 division; and

26 WHEREAS, due to his outstanding athletic abilities, Mr.
27 Conner has received several rankings, including being ranked as



28 No. 5 out of the state's 40 best recruits by the Clarion-Ledger,
29 ranked as the No. 13 quarterback prospect in the country on
30 ESPN.Com by Tom Lemming, a recruiting analyst, and he was listed
31 among the top 30 quarterbacks in the nation by Phil Grosz in the
32 preseason G&W Recruiting Report, and twice ranked by PrepStar
33 Magazine among the top 10 quarterbacks in the Southeast and as the
34 No. 7 player overall in the state in its season-ending all-America
35 issue; and

36 WHEREAS, Omarr Conner has developed a winning and cooperative
37 spirit and a superb degree of sportsmanship, and his athletic
38 abilities and attitude reflect great credit upon his coaches and
39 bring great honor to Noxubee County High School; and

40 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Legislature of the State of
41 Mississippi to recognize and commend excellence, especially when
42 shown by a young individual of our state such as Omarr Conner, who
43 is its future:

44 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
45 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
46 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Omarr Conner
47 for his outstanding football career and wish him much success in
48 all of his future endeavors.
