17 the Panama Canal Zone to complete his residency before moving home
18 to begin his practice in September 1963; and

19 WHEREAS, Dr. Munn practiced medicine in his hometown for many
20 years, having been offered many opportunities to accept more
21 lucrative offers in specialty practices; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Munn has served as Chief of Staff at Simpson
23 General Hospital for many years, where he has improved the
24 services and programs for the people of Simpson County; and

25 WHEREAS, Dr. Munn was named Outstanding Citizen of the Year
26 by the Mendenhall Chamber of Commerce; and



27 WHEREAS, Dr. Munn has been lovingly supported in all his
28 endeavors by his wife and high school sweetheart, the former Betty
29 Sue Cockrell; their children, Jon Alan, Jennifer, Janna and Jason,
