HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 44

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING ALL SAINTS' EPISCOPAL SCHOOL FOR MANY  
2 YEARS OF PROVIDING OUTSTANDING EDUCATION.

3 WHEREAS, All Saints' Episcopal School is a small,  
4 independent, coeducational, college preparatory school for  
5 boarding students in Grades 8 through 12 and day students in  
6 Grades 7 through 12; and

7 WHEREAS, All Saints' welcomes young people from a wide  
8 variety of ethnic, racial, religious, economic, social and  
9 geographic backgrounds; and

10 WHEREAS, the school was first envisioned by the Right  
11 Reverend William Mercer Green, the first Episcopal Bishop of  
12 Mississippi, who in 1860 determined the need for a diocesan school  
13 for girls; and

14 WHEREAS, in 1908, Bishop Theodore Dubose Bratton,  
15 Mississippi's third Episcopal Bishop, established All Saints'  
16 Episcopal College as an all girls college, and in 1971, All  
17 Saints' became a coeducational boarding and day institution for  
18 secondary school students; and

19 WHEREAS, throughout the many years of providing education,  
20 All Saints' has been dedicated to nurturing the intellectual,  
21 physical, spiritual and social growth of its students in a  
22 lovingly structured environment; and

23 WHEREAS, located in the historic City of Vicksburg, All  
24 Saints' is situated on forty acres of landscaped hills with campus  
25 buildings that curve in an arc around a dell in which the Olympic  
26 size swimming pool and recreation center are located; and



27           WHEREAS, All Saints' Episcopal School is owned by the  
28 Episcopal Dioceses of Mississippi, Arkansas, Louisiana and Western  
29 Louisiana; and

30           WHEREAS, representatives from those dioceses, including their  
31 bishops, along with All Saints' Rector and Head, comprise the  
32 twenty-member board of trustees; and

33           WHEREAS, All Saints' Episcopal School is accredited by the  
34 Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and holds memberships  
35 in the Southern Association of Independent Schools, the National  
36 Association of Independent Schools, the National Association of  
37 Episcopal Schools, the Southern Association of Boarding Schools,  
38 the National Association of Boarding Schools and the College  
39 Board; and

40           WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to  
41 recognize and commend excellence especially when evidenced by  
42 outstanding schools such as All Saints' Episcopal School, which  
43 has committed itself to providing outstanding educations to many  
44 young people:

45           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
46 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do commend  
47 All Saints' Episcopal School for many years of providing  
48 outstanding educations and express our warmest wishes for  
49 continued success in all their future endeavors.

50           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be  
51 furnished to All Saints' Episcopal School and to the members of  
52 the Capitol Press Corps.
