## SENATE BILL NO. 2084

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-32-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE FOR SUSPENSION OF DRIVER'S LICENSE OR PERMIT OF
- TO PROVIDE FOR SUSPENSION OF DRIVER'S LICENSE OR PERMIT OF YOUTHFUL OFFENDERS IN POSSESSION OF TOBACCO; AND FOR RELATED
- 4 PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-32-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 97-32-13. (1) Any person under the age of eighteen (18)
- 9 years who falsely states he is eighteen (18) years of age or
- 10 older, or presents any document that indicates he is eighteen (18)
- 11 years of age or older, for the purpose of purchasing or possessing
- 12 any tobacco or tobacco product shall be penalized not less than
- 13 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars
- 14 (\$200.00) or required to complete at least thirty (30) days
- 15 community service, or both.
- 16 (2) (a) Any person under the age of eighteen (18) years who
- 17 violates the provisions of this chapter, in addition to any other
- 18 punishment authorized by law, shall have his driver's license
- 19 suspended for a period of thirty (30) days for the first offense,
- or shall have his driver's license suspended for three (3) months
- 21 for a second or subsequent offense.
- (b) Upon conviction or adjudication of any person under
- 23 the age of eighteen (18) years for a violation of this chapter,
- 24 the judge shall notify the Commissioner of Public Safety of the
- 25 adjudication on a form to be devised by the commissioner. The
- 26 commissioner or his authorized agent shall suspend the driver's
- 27 license or permit to drive or deny the issuance of a license or
- 28 permit to the person as provided in this subsection (2).

29 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

30 and after July 1, 2003.
