SENATE BILL NO. 2667

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE SONG "MISSISSIPPI" BY EDWARD OWEN
 2 MILLER AS THE OFFICIAL SONG OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO REPEAL
 3 CHAPTER 654, GENERAL LAWS 1962, WHICH DESIGNATED THE SONG "GO,
 4 MISSISSIPPI" BY HOUSTON DAVIS AS THE OFFICIAL SONG OF THE STATE OF
 5 MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** The song "Mississippi" by Edward Owen Miller is
 8 designated as the official song of the State of Mississippi.

9 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 654, General Laws 1962, which designated
 10 the song "Go, Mississippi" by Houston Davis as the official state
 11 song, is repealed.

12 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
 13 and after its passage.
