- 3 SUPREME COURT JUSTICE POSITIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-991, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 23-15-991. The term of office of judges of the Supreme Court
- 8 shall be eight (8) years. \* \* \* An election shall be held on the
- 9 first Tuesday after the first Monday in November immediately
- 10 preceding the expiration of the term of an incumbent in the
- 11 Supreme Court district from which <u>each</u> incumbent was elected, and
- 12 likewise each eighth year thereafter, at which there shall be
- 13 elected a successor to the incumbent, whose term of office shall
- 14 thereafter begin on the first Monday of January of the year in
- 15 which the term of the incumbent he succeeds expires.
- 16 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 17 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 18 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 19 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 20 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 21 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 22 extended.
- 23 **SECTION 3**. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after January 1, 2006, provided it is effectuated under
- 25 Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
