SENATE BILL NO. 2958

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS TO THE  
2 MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
6 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Dental  
7 Examiners, for the support of said board for the fiscal year  
8 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.....  
9 ..... \$ 600,939.00.

10 **SECTION 2.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of  
11 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be  
12 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of  
13 expenditure:

30           With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of  
31 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to  
32 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal  
33 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004  
34 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions  
35 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the  
36 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the  
37 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall  
38 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all  
39 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this  
40 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure  
41 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual  
42 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal  
43 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,  
44 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken  
45 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected  
46 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services"  
47 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which  
48 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation  
49 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until  
50 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

51           Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with  
52 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

53           No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be  
54 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are  
55 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this  
56 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

57           **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none  
58 of the funds appropriated in this act shall be authorized for the  
59 purchase of surveillance equipment.



60           **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none  
61 of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for  
62 increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance  
63 Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and  
64 Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for  
65 the health insurance plan.

66           **SECTION 5.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of  
67 this act, Twenty-two Thousand Two Hundred Eleven Dollars  
68 (\$22,211.00) may be used to reallocate or reclassify existing  
69 positions of this agency.

70           **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
71 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the  
72 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon  
73 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal  
74 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the  
75 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

76           **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
77 and after July 1, 2003.
