SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 11

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MS. SARAH NEWMAN UPON HER
2 PARTICIPATION IN THE 2002 USA INTERNATIONAL BALLET COMPETITION.

4 to compete in the 2002 USA International Ballet Competition, which
5 took place at Thalia Mara Hall in Jackson in June 2002; and

6 WHEREAS, Ms. Newman, a resident of Brookhaven, Mississippi,
7 competed with over 100 dancers from 24 different countries and was
8 one of only 17 total dancers representing the United States; and

9 WHEREAS, having trained under Jennifer Beasley for the past
10 nine years, Ms. Newman participated in the Joffrey Ballet Summer
11 Program and the prestigious American Ballet Theater Summer
12 Workshop; and

13 WHEREAS, Ms. Newman was named Junior Miss, which is primarily
14 a scholarship program that promotes excellence and encourages
15 young ladies to be the best they can be, and proudly represented
16 Brookhaven and Lincoln County in the statewide pageant in July;

18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Newman, the daughter of Henry and Vickie
19 Newman, is an outstanding student at Brookhaven Academy; and

20 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
21 and commend excellence, especially when evidenced by the
22 outstanding young people of our state such as Ms. Newman:

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE
24 SENATE, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Ms. Sarah
25 Newman upon her participation in the 2002 USA International Ballet
