We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1552: Appropriation; Rehabilitation Services - Consolidated.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 4 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 5 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 6 Rehabilitation Services for the fiscal year beginning 7 July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004...... \$ 7,282,777.00. 8 9 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 10 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of 11 Rehabilitation Services which is comprised of special source funds 12 collected by or otherwise available to the department for the 13 support of the various offices of the department, for the purpose 14 of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year 15 16 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.......\$ 108,017,056.00. 17 18 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 19 Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, for the 20 purpose of defraying the expenses of the Department of 21 Rehabilitation Services for the fiscal year beginning 22 23 July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.....\$ 7,277,878.00. 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     that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
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     cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal
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     Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
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     the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
     action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
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     annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services"
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     appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
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     reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
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     requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
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     such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
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          It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive
     Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer
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     between the various offices authorized herein both funds and
     positions not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the receiving
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     office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in
     accordance with Section 27-104-17 (3), Mississippi Code of 1972,
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     Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of
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     Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the
     transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of
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     Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month
     prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the
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     intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the
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     provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and
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     that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially
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     alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth
     in the original appropriations made under this act.
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          No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
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used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

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act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 206 207 SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 208 209 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi 210 211 Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year 212 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004...... 213\$ 4,000,000.00. 214 SECTION 6. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 215 216 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 217 218 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 219 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof. 220 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 221 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 222 223 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 7. Of the funds in Sections 1, 2 and 3, the 224 225 Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services through the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind is authorized to 226 227 expend an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the National Federation for the Blind (NFB) 228 229 Newsline service to allow blind and visually impaired persons to 230 access newspapers through toll-free telephone calls. SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 231 232 Section 2, Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, 233 Mississippi Code of 1972. 234 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 235 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 236 237 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 238 239 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
