- 9 application of any citizen of the state, and shall have the
- 10 authority to issue injunctions or writs of mandamus to accomplish
- 11 that purpose. <u>If a court finds that a public body has willfully</u>
- 12 and knowingly violated the provisions of this chapter, the
- 13 individual members of that public body shall be liable civilly in
- 14 <u>a sum not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), plus all</u>
- 15 reasonable expenses incurred by such person or persons bringing
- 16 the lawsuit.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2003.
